SYMPOSIUM

For the **symposium as a whole**, a general abstract is required which answers a limited number of specific questions concerning the symposium/theme. For each of the individual contributions (3) a general abstract as well as an extended summary is required, providing more detailed information about each of the contributing papers. Please note that: When submitting your proposal through the conference system, you will first need to save and submit each individual paper, before submitting the symposium as a whole.

General symposium

Session Title of the symposium (max 100 characters including spaces).

Session Description (= General abstract) (100 - 200 words) which should contain the following:

1. Describe the main theme and the aims/objectives of the symposium.
2. How will the chair ensure interactivity of the symposium. Please consider any type of media and specify the method, tool, format... chosen.

Symposium contributions (3)

Session Title of the contribution (each presentation) (max. 100 characters including spaces).

Session Description (= individual symposium) (100 - 200 words) which should contain the following: what are the central research questions, the methodology used, the research results and main conclusions for educational practice?



Extended summary (250 - 1000 words) per individual symposium contribution. You can upload this in the 'Files' step in the submission process - which should give an answer to the following questions:

1. Which theoretical background and/or earlier research results is the practice-based research based on?
2. What are the research questions in this practice-based research?
3. Which research design, instruments and methods for data analysis are used in the research as presented?
4. What are the research results?
5. What are the main conclusions and/or interpretations drawn in this practice-based research?
6. How does the research support the current field of practice-based educational research and/or how does it improve (future) educational practice?
7. How will you ensure interactivity in your presentation? Please consider any type of media and specify the method, tool, format... chosen.

Add the name of the **chair** and the name of **one discussant**.

List of references

Please include your list of references as an attachment to your submission.

Review questions (1-10 Rating Scale)

1. Is the theoretical or practical background of this practice-based research clear and justified?
2. Are the research questions clear?
3. Are the research design, instruments, and methods of analysis appropriately chosen and rigorously implemented?
4. Are the research results clearly described?
5. Are the conclusions and interpretations drawn in this study presented clearly and justified (i.e. by the data, results, or examples)?
6. Does the research address important, and/or new and emerging issues within the field of practice-based educational research or offer ideas for practice improvement?
7. Does the proposal offer good ideas that will help the presentation to succeed in being interactive?
